Initial Steps To Be Taken



GP Surgery or Bereavement Services electronically sent Medical Certificate for Cause of Death (Death Certificate) to registrars



Appointment arranged with the registrar



Finding Documents Required: Medical Certificate for Cause of Death, Birth Certificate, Medical Card, Marriage Certificate (IA)



Check if deceased had a will, written instructions for a funeral, Pre-Paid Plan or Pre-Arranged their funeral



Inform Solicitor (IA)



Made appointment with Funeral Director



Official Documents To Obtain At Registration



Obtained a Registrars Certificate for Burial or Cremation (for Funeral Directors Use only)



Purchased sufficient copies of the Certified Copy of Entry of Death (we usually recommend at least 6 copies)



Form BD8 for Department of Work and Pensions

Registrar's Certificate for burial or cremation (IA)



Wording for Newspaper Notice



Number of Limousines Required



Funeral From/Return Address



Catering Requirements



Service Sheets - Number Required / Photograph(s) for Cover
